Growth

From a humble beginning of only 36 students in as recently as 2017, our strength has grown exponentially, as shown on the projection, to an impressive assemblage of close to 630 students in the current academic year of 2024-25. This year our second batch of Gr 10 students will be appearing for the CBSE examination.

Academic Achievement

Our school takes immense pride in the outstanding academic achievements of our students in the CBSE Grade 10 Examination 2024. All 14 students who appeared for the examination secured a 100% pass result, with 13 students achieving distinction.

Niya Jabbar emerged as the school topper with a score of 94%, closely followed by Fila Fathima Sudheer and Hana Fathima.

Infrastructure Development and Progress

Aspire School is steadfast in its commitment to providing a dynamic and supportive learning environment for its students. The following advancements in infrastructure and facilities during the year highlight this dedication:

- A new multi-purpose hall, art room and library in the annexe building.
- Enhanced horse-riding facilities to provide students with better training opportunities.
- Implementation of a GPS-enabled transportation system for safer and more efficient travel.
- Addition of two new buses to the school fleet: a 32-seater Eicher Starline AC bus and a 22-seater Tata Winger AC bus.
- Introduction of four new bus routes, bringing the total number of routes to 22.
- *Kalari*, the traditional martial art form, has been introduced as an extracurricular activity to promote cultural and physical development.
- Monthly 'Meet-the-Teacher' sessions are conducted alongside regular PTMs, facilitating stronger communication between parents and teachers.
- Deployment of additional security staff within the school premises to enhance monitoring and ensuring the safety of students and staff.
- A vegetable garden, collaboratively maintained by students and staff, promoting hands-on learning and sustainability.

The Way Ahead

As we conclude another successful year, the school remains focussed on advancing its vision with concrete plans to ensure sustained growth and development. Key targets for the near future include:

- Launching the Balvatika 1 pre-school class and associated facilities.
